### 3. WHO: AUTHOR/EDITOR/TRANSLATOR

*By whom was it written/compiled? In what capacity did this person(s) write/compile this? What is the POV (point of view/bias) of the writer?*

*Has this document been edited? If so, by whom, when, for what purpose?*

*Has this document been translated? If so, by whom, when, for what purpose?*

### 4. WHY?

*For what purpose was this document written?*

*For what purpose was this document preserved? How was it preserved?*

**5. HOW?**

*How was this document circulated/or was it?*

**6. CONTENT**

*What is the content of the document?*

**7. Whom did this document affect?**

*Is the reception of this document known/revealed in this piece?*

*Are there other documents that tell a different version/different side of the issues here?*
