## Word From Your Faculty Director

On behalf of your Change LLC theme team, we want to wish you the best in your course planning this week as you prepare for registration. Remember that we are all here to help you. Here are a few additional reminders for registration:

- <u>Holds:</u> Get your hold released before you register by contacting your Preceptor.
- <u>Course Planning:</u> As you are searching for classes, you may notice that they are filling up fast so please have backup schedule options. You can do this with USD's new "Plan Ahead" tool: from your Mysandiego portal > Torero Hub > My Academics; under Registration Tools > New Add/Drop Registration > Registration > Plan Ahead > Add the classes that you plan to register for and Save it.
- <u>Registration Day:</u> On your set time to register, you can register by entering each CRN individually (old way). Or you can use the new way that integrates the information from your Plan Ahead tool directly noted above for your proposed course schedule(s). To

use the new Registration tool: Go to New Add/Drop Registration > enter the term > the top will say Register for Classes and under there is a tab that says Plans. Go to your Plan and click Add All on the top right. Then go to the bottom right and click Submit.

- <u>New Classes:</u> Some departments will add additional course sections between now and the start of classes in January so please continue to check the schedules.
- **Waitlist**: If you get a spot on the waitlist, please be sure to regularly check your e-mail account because you only have 24 hours to claim a spot in the class when your name is selected from the waitlist.


