TASK: Create a Jam on Google Jamboard. If you need a tutorial, there are many on YouTube, but [here is one](#) that is quick and to the point. Take a moment to check out [my Jam](#) and notice the following key elements that need to be included on yours to receive full credit:

- Main research topic
 - 2-3 possible subtopics
- Primary sources
 - 1 work of art with image
- Secondary sources
 - 2-4 mix of academic books or journal articles
- Key search terms (ideally LC)
 - 6–10 terms
- Databases consulted

TIPS:

- Title your Jam with your name; otherwise when Millie and I receive them they are hard to tell apart or find if they are simply called Jam for Islamic Art. Ideally title it: Your First Name – Islamic Art Jam (Fall 2023)
- Make sure you click on the “Share” settings; choose University of San Diego and choose editing rights, in case we want to offer a comment directly on your Jam. Then email it directly to: [Mille Fullmer](#) and [Kate Dimitrova](#). You **do not** need to submit anything to Bb, but you do need to email it to us before 11:59 PM on Monday, Oct. 16 for it to be counted as an on-time submission.
- If you need more room, you can always add more frames to your Jam. Be as detailed and specific as possible to show that you were engaged in the library workshop and that you have applied the knowledge you learned.
- Later, when it comes time for your presentations to the class, you can always drop a PDF of your jam into your PowerPoint/Pages/Canvas presentation to show others your research and writing process.
